Hazel Dell Elementary staff is committed to the goal of providing quality education for every child in our school. Everyone gains if parents are partners with teachers and other staff in the education of their children.

Hazel Dell Elementary staff believes that improving student academic achievement requires parents have an understanding of curriculum, academic achievement standards, assessments, district/school policies and procedures, and how to monitor their children's progress and work with educators, and is committed to doing what it takes.

Parent Participation Plan-Hazel Dell staff will jointly develop/revise with parents the school Parent Participation Plan at a Parent Advisory Committee Meeting. Each May, the School-Parent Compact will be reviewed and revised with the input of parents for the following school year.

Annual Title I Meeting-An annual meeting to inform parents of Hazel Dell's participation as a Title I Schoolwide site, the requirement of Title I, and the rights of the parent to be involved, will occur at the Parent Participation meeting on Curriculum Nights offered by each grade on various dates in the fall. Information about Title I will also be available during parent-teacher conferences in October and upon request.

Parent-Teacher Conferences (student-led conferences)- Parents are provided opportunities to meet with classroom teachers during the district's scheduled Monday early-release time from 12:45–1:45. Alternative meeting times are offered upon parent request as well as by Zoom. During fall conferences, the Parent/School Compact is reviewed and signed. Spring conferences are scheduled as needed during Monday early-release time. Parents are encouraged to meet with their child's teacher at any time throughout the school year. Throughout the academic year, families are provided with reasonable access to staff and multiple opportunities to participate in school-sponsored activities. All teachers use ParentSquare for ongoing, two-way communication with families.

SBAC Information Night – April 2026, families with students in Grade 3 will have an opportunity to learn more about the State assessment and have a chance to take the practice test together with their child.

Curriculum, Assessments & Proficiency Levels-All parents will be notified of their child's assessment scores and eligibility for additional academic help during the school day. Parents are informed of student progress via the Goal Setting Conference in the fall and the Trimester Report Cards. Parents are encouraged to request information regarding their child's academic progress at any time from the school staff.

Parent Advisory Group (PTA) -Meets monthly with the Principal.

Hazel Dell Elementary students are instructed by teachers trained in the use Common Core State Standards (CCSS) to achieve benchmark level or above. Students requiring additional reading help may participate in programs such as Learning Assistance Program (LAP) or Title I. All students in grades K-5 are instructed in Eureka Math. Students are assessed in a variety of ways

including mClass (Amplify) math and mClass reading (DIBELS) and Progress Monitoring, Smarter Balanced Assessment, and curriculum-based and classroom-based measures.

Hazel Dell staff will participate in a variety of professional development opportunities throughout the school year. Staff will participate in both building and district level professional development focused on improving parent and school partnerships.

Hazel Dell staff has a philosophy that every teacher is a reading and math teacher. The district's Literacy and Math Model, core curriculum materials, and Common Core State Standards guide the instruction for staff. All Federal, State and local resources that relate to reading and math instruction are coordinated to benefit student academic achievement.

Information related to Hazel Dell parent programs, meetings, and other activities will be sent to parents in the school newsletter, through classroom news bulletins, and posted on the school website. Every attempt will be made to clearly communicate information in the parents' native language.
