Each May, the School-Parent Compact will be reviewed and revised with the input of parents for the following school year.

<u>Annual Title I Meeting</u>-An annual meeting to inform parents of Hazel Dell's participation as a Title I Schoolwide site, the requirement of Title I, and the rights of the parent to be involved, will occur at the Parent Participation meeting on Curriculum Nights offered by each grade on various dates in the fall. Information about Title I will also be available during parent-teacher conferences in October and upon request.

<u>Parent-Teacher Conferences (student-led conferences)</u>- Parents are provided an opportunity to meet with classroom teachers during the district's scheduled conference days in October 2020. During the fall conference time, the Parent/School Compact will be reviewed and signed. Spring Conferences are scheduled in April 2021. Parents are encouraged to meet with their children's teachers at any time during the school year. Throughout the academic year, parents will be provided with reasonable access to staff and opportunities to participate in a variety of school sponsored activities. Most teachers use Class Dojo or SeeSaw for two-way communication throughout the year.

<u>SBAC Information Night</u> – April 2021, families with students in Grade 3 will have an opportunity to learn more about the State assessment and have a chance to take the practice test together with their child.

<u>Curriculum</u>, <u>Assessments & Proficiency Levels</u>-All parents will be notified of their child's assessment scores and eligibility for additional academic help during the school day, or in summer programs. Parents are informed of student progress via the Goal Setting Conference in the fall and the Trimester Report Cards. Parents are encouraged to request information regarding their child's academic progress at any time from the school staff.

<u>Drive-through Bingo-</u> In May 2021, families are invited to attend the drive-through bingo event led by students

Parent Advisory Group-Meets monthly with the Principal and FCRC

Hazel Dell Elementary students are instructed by teachers trained in the use Common Core State Standards (CCSS) to achieve benchmark level or above. Students requiring additional reading help may participate in programs such as Learning Assistance Program (LAP) or Title I. All students in grades K-5 are instructed Eureka Math. Students are assessed in a variety of ways including i-Ready Diagnostic and Progress Monitoring, Smarter Balanced Assessment, and curriculum-based and classroom-based measures.

Hazel Dell staff will participate in a variety of professional development opportunities throughout the school year. Staff will participate in both building and district level professional development focused on improving parent and school partnerships.

Hazel Dell staff has a philosophy that every teacher is a reading and math teacher. The district's Literacy and Math Model, core curriculum materials, and Common Core State Standards guide the instruction for staff. All Federal, State and local resources that relate to reading and math instruction are coordinated to benefit student academic achievement.

Information related to Hazel Dell parent programs, meetings, and other activities will be sent to parents in the school newsletter, through classroom news bulletins, and posted on the school website. Every attempt will be made to clearly communicate information in the parents' native language.
